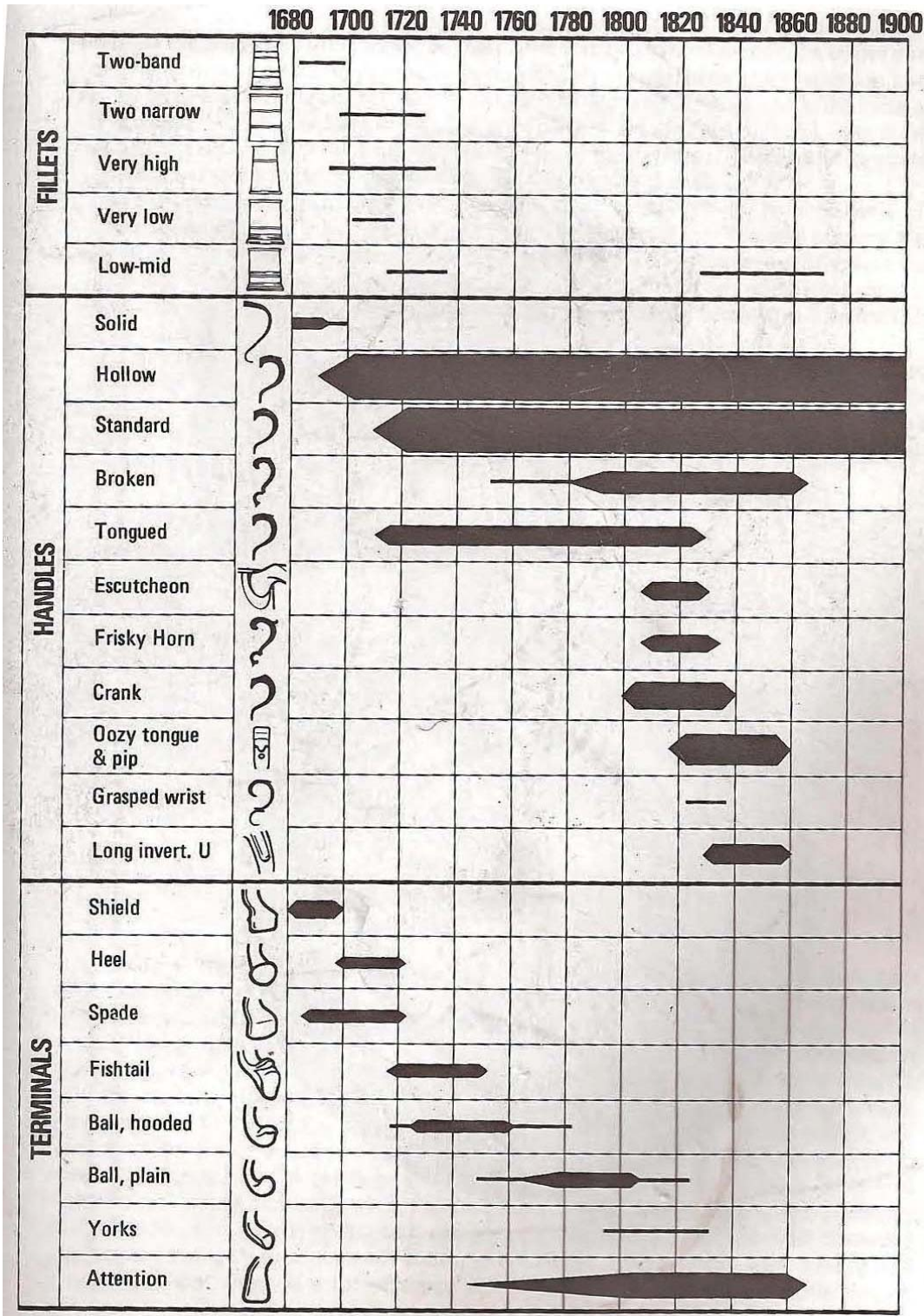


# SOME FEATURES OF TAVERN PEWTER MUGS AND A GUIDE TO DATING THEM
