GUILD - CANDELABRA

A pewter 6-armed Candelabra with figurines.

This is a Swiss Guild piece made for a Butcher's Slaughterer's Guild. The figurines are the butchers, the platter on their shoulders for the pieces of meat. The big axe was probably that used to cut up the body of a cow through the middle whilst hung.

It is likely Swiss from Zurich made between 1820 and 1830. The Guild claims to have been formed in 1336.
