*Faked hall marks (usually applied in a straight  
row when faked using one punch whereas  
originally four would have been used), faked  
rose & crown (always rubbed in similar ways to  
disguise the outer edges), hunting scene likely  
added during first half of the 1900s. (Amateur  
artwork unlikely/not of 1780.)*

*Clearly this is a reputable seller who perhaps  
did not know what they were selling, despite  
impressive approval rating.*
